1. Official transcripts of all academic work (undergraduate and any graduate classes), received by the chairperson directly from the institutions.
2. Proof of admission to an American Library Association-accredited Master's program/library school, i.e., a letter from the dean of the school certifying your acceptance (photocopies are acceptable).
3. State briefly your reasons for wanting to be a librarian and your ultimate professional goals. You will probably want to attach this essay on a separate sheet.
