

Stick Pick

Grade: Any Grade Level

Price: \$2.99

Created by Sixth Grade Teacher, Buzz Garwood


Description: Random Name Generator that display "question stems" that are tied to <u>each</u> learner's cognitive or English language ability level.

Application: Can you to promote higher order thinking and even save student answer data. Can generate reports to share to review or share with parents.



<u>Features that will incrementally make it into Stick Pick</u> Import/export of student data, syncing across devices, making anecdotal records.

Mobile Mouse Lite (Remote/Trackpad for the iPad)

- Description: This app allows you to control your computer or other device with your iPad.

- Cost: \$4.99
- Allows remote access anywhere/anytime.

- Not an App; however, a download for your computer.
- Wireless mirror's your iPad through your computer to your LCD projector for whole class viewing.

- No need for Apple TV

Nearpod

Grade: Middle and High School

Price: Free

Location: App Store

Description: This app allows you to use your iPad to manage content on students' iOS devices. It combines presentation, collaboration, a real-time assessment tools into one integrated solution.

Application:

- Teachers log in to <u>www.nearpod.com</u> to create multimedia presentations with interactive features such as quizzes, polls, drawing tools, videos, and more
- In the classroom, teachers log into the Nearpod iPad app to share content with their students and manage the flow of the lecture. Students use the Nearpod app to receive curricular content, participate in activities and submit responses. Student have to enter the presentation pin #. It will not allow them to wander from the specific presentation. Students can work at their own pace.
- Assessment: Teachers receive real time answers and can log into www.nearpod.com to retrieve assessment after sessions.


- Input math and logic characters using the custom math keyboard






- Short answer questions, quizzes, multiple choice questions, space race, exit tickets
