





Video Vocab





MPEG Streamclip is a powerful free video converter, player, editor for Mac and Windows. It can play many movie files, not only MPEGs; it can convert MPEG files between muxed/demuxed formats for authoring; it can encode movies to many formats, including iPod; it can cut, trim and join movies. MPEG Streamclip can also download videos from YouTube and Google by entering the page URL.

You can use MPEG Streamclin to open and play most movie formats including MPEG files or transport.





One stops to change a tire, while others go vrocom.


The last speedy race car, around the track it zooms.

- Install OverDrive Media Console (OMC) app.
- Open OMCapp.
- Tap Get Books icon on screen.
- Tap Add a Library, search for KCLS.
- Tap a library, tap star next to name.

BROWSE

- In the OMCapp, tap Get Books.
- Tap library name to see catalog.

eReaders & Digital Downloads: Get Started

Checkout and Download your eBooks

- Browse or search for downloads limit to eBooks from the Quick Search menu atop each page or use the left side browse menus
 - o Titles that say "add to bag" are available now
 - Titles that say "place a hold" are unavailable, but you will receive an email when it's ready, should you choose to place the hold
 - · Add desired titles to your Book Bag via 'add to bag' links
- · Checkout via 'Proceed to Checkout' links
- Login with your library ID and password to checkout items
- · Following checkout, click the 'download' link to copy each title to your computer

Copy your eBooks to your eReader

- · Plug your eReader into your computer via manufacturer-supplied cable
- · Launch Adobe Digital Editions
- · Open new eBooks in Adobe Digital Editions
- Drag titles onto eReader name displayed in left side menu you may need to close then re-open Adobe Digital Editions (with eReader plugged in) to see eReader displayed
- Eject eReader according to your computer's accepted protocol (via System Tray in Windows, via Finder in Mac)
- · Unplug your eReader from computer
- · Enjoy your new eBook!

Frequently Asked Questions

What eBook format do I select?

Most eReaders work well with EPUB and PDF. App users (Android, iPad, iPod Touch, iPhone, Blackberry, Windows Phone) are limited to EPUB.

What are the borrowing limits?

You are limited to 20 simultaneous checkouts from OverDrive and may have up to 10 holds. Lending periods are your choice – select 7, 14 or 21 days for any eBook.

Are there renewals on eBooks?

No, though you many checkout the same title again if no holds are in place.

How do I return a book early?

- . Open Adobe Digital Editions and select your eReader in the left side menu
- · Click on the book and then the resulting arrow
- · Select 'Return Borrowed Item'
