The committee recommended aiming for Thursday sessions in order to secure best turnouts for the programs.

Karen Manning will check with Rhonda Boozer that she will continue to handle the Paraprofessional Awards this year. A suggestion was made to put the pictures of last years award winners in the Spring GLA Quarterly to promote the coming 2008 awards and encourage participation.
