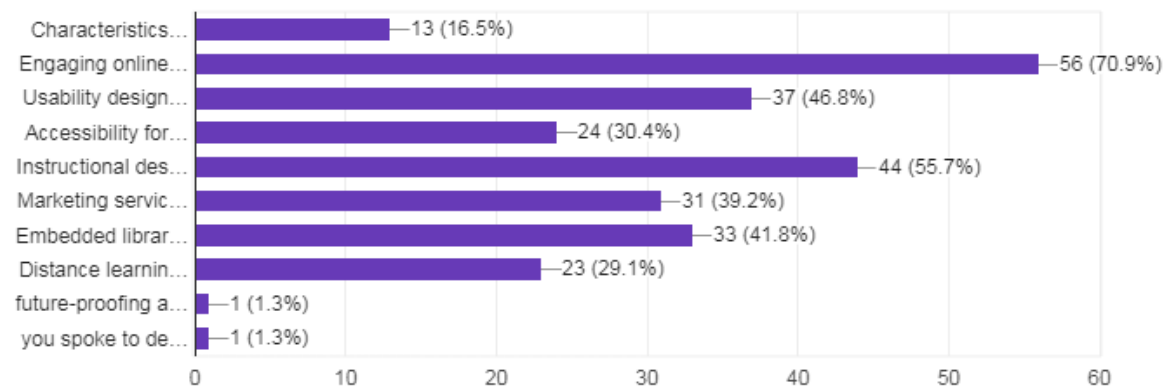

Survey Results

The following results are from a survey distributed by the Interest Group via the GLA List-serv from Oct. 13 to Nov 1, 2017. We received 79 responses. Users could select more than one response for each question.

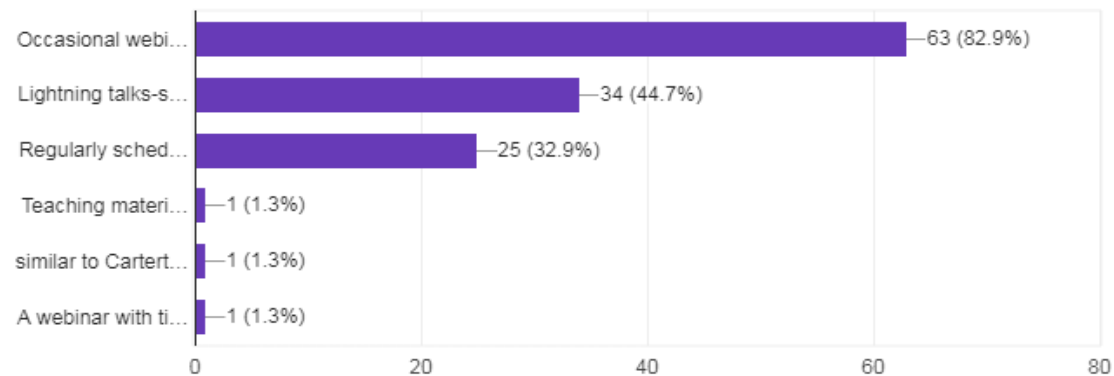
What topic or topics would most interest you?

What formats would you like to see DLIG offer?

- [Survey](#) open to GLA membership during the month of October 2017
- Overwhelming (83%) results preferring single speaker webinar with single topic
- Three big topics: Engaging Online Learners (71%), Instructional Design for Distance Learning (56%), and Usability Design (47%)
- Does “Engaging Online Learners” mean promoting active learning or does it mean attracting online learners to our services?
- Aim for single webinar early in the Spring

Webinar Planning

- Don't want to conflict with ALA Midwinter or GLA Midwinter
- What if we aimed for March?
- Invite Joelle Pitts to speak and work with schedule or ask if she knows anyone else
- Give her the option of topics voted on by our survey OR a related topic of her choice?
- Ashley will contact her
- Mary Ann has the most WebEX experience and will be in charge of that
- Publicize at GLA listserv - should we have people sign up?
- Jason suggested we use GSU's LibCal for participant registration - we can use Evite or Google Forms as backup
 - Jason is checking with GSU admins to make sure this is okay.

- Work on finding a sponsored session at GLC, possibly another panel with different members
- GLC Panel Discussion
 - What if we did a different theme every year?
- Summer Lightning Talk workshop idea

GLA Midwinter Meeting

- Will be January 19th
- Last year we only had 3 participants, so how can we get more people to show up?
- Maybe we should advertise to the listserv before Midwinter so that more people attend the interest group meeting
- Mary Ann will email GLA listserv to invite people to our meeting in January

Interest Group Communication

- We are looking for a way for members to communicate about Distance issues; prevailing idea is a listserv, but we are worried about starting new listserv if GLA administration does not approve interest group listservs
- Web forums have the problem of no one visiting them
- We will wait until we hear from GLA administration to decide what to do

Handbook entry

- We have set up a Google doc to collaboratively work on improving the interest group's entry in the GLA Handbook. The current entry is only one brief paragraph.
- Interest group leadership will asynchronously work on the document and hope for final approval at the Midwinter meeting.
