
New Interest Group!

SPOTLIGHT ON: GWINNETT COUNTY PUBLIC LIBRARY

Gwinnett County Public Library (GCPL) is the public library system of Gwinnett County, Georgia, in the metro Atlanta area. Established in 1936, this public library system has 15 branches. Two new buildings for the Duluth and Norcross branches will open this year. These branches experience high material circulation and have special items like children's bilingual materials, WiFi hotspots, and launchpads available for checkout. Several current and upcoming branch buildings house Learning Labs, rooms that act as makerspaces for the public, where customers can come to use and learn how to use 3D printers, sewing machines, audio equipment, and other tools, GCPL also hosts thousands of programs every year. This year, they created hundreds of virtual programs and other digital content.

As GCPL weathered the storm of COVID-19, the system was involved in much-needed outreach activities for its community. Working with local food banks, coalitions, and even a local chef, Hank Reid, GCPL gave meals to community members throughout the pandemic when many jobs were lost or put on hold. The library system also created teams made up of staff members to sew masks for local hospitals and collect donated items for the North Gwinnett Coalition. GCPL prides itself on community, innovation, and partnerships, and it shows in everything that they do.
