## <u>Introduction to Research and Education at the National Archives and Carter</u> Presidential Library

This workshop is designed as an introduction for students or professionals who are unfamiliar with the programs and resources of the Carter Presidential Library and National Archives. Participants are provided an overview of National Archives resources and the Library's onsite and distance learning programming options for teachers and students, with an emphasis on online research tools and resources available.

Speaker: Josh Montanari has served as the Carter Library Education Specialist since 2017. He spent the previous decade working as a Park Ranger, first for Pennsylvania DCNR, then transitioning to the National Park Service in 2010 at Sitka National Historical Park in southeast Alaska. Over the next seven years he would work or volunteer full-time in interpretation and

education at some better and lesser known NPS units, including Kalaupapa National Historical Park (HI), Crater Lake National Park (OR), Mesa Verde National Park (CO), Salem Maritime National Historic Site (MA), Denali National Park & Preserve (AK), and the NPS Chesapeake Bay Office (MD).
